Restoration of our Trailer

The Chefs' Long Table Charity Lunch's equipment trailer has a new life, thanks to the Southern Ports Authority and Yookson Road Engineering.

The trailer, built 12 years ago to carry trestle tables originally doubled as the event stage. It now carries 52 table tops and 160 trestles to each annual event. Through its 15 years' life the trailer had sustained quite a bit of minor damage as well as general wear and tear. The Committee in keeping with its risk and safety awareness, ordered that repairs and refurbishments be urgently undertaken to ensure the safety of our volunteers.

Julie Combes, Yookson Road Engineering and her staff, in true Chefs Long Table spirit donated extensive time

and labour to stripping back the trailer ready for a total rebuild, making an in-kind contribution of around \$5,000. Julie has offered to carry out any required maintenance following each Charity Lunch, stressing that this is one way they could give back to the community and support the important work of the beneficiaries.

Southern Ports Authority, a regular sponsor of The Chefs Long Table Charity Lunch events over the years, once again provided the very generous grant which enabled purchase of essential materials and equipment. 

2019 Beneficiaries

Bunbury Volunteer Fire and Rescue Purchase of a digital projector, screen and PA to be used in training emergency service volunteers specifically in procedures, equipment components and application. The equipment will assist in demonstrating fire and rescue techniques at community events, open days, schools and school-based Emergency Services Cadet groups.





Dalyellap Seasons Shed Purchase materials for members to make timber toys, doll's houses, cubby houses and more to be donated to assist fund raising focussed on giving to children in need. Members donated an attractive, well-crafted Rocking Horse last year and will donate a "surprise" item for this year's auction.

Leschenault Catchment Council Building possum and bat nesting boxes for installation in residential areas towards harmonious co-existence of people, possums and bats. The Western Ring Tailed Possum has recently been declared a threatened species with less than 8,000 individuals left, they are endemic to and are only found in the South West of WA. A Register of sightings will be maintained and reported with resident's help.





Newton Moore Senior High School Purchase of coffee machines which will enable Year 11 & 12 students to gain Barista accreditation and expand their work skills and employability opportunities. A small-scale enterprise will see an occasional café where students can gain first-hand experience serving staff and small functions. Students will learn skills required for managing a business, customer service, time management plus cooking skills and have an opportunity to explore sustainability ideas such as alternatives to disposable cups and recyclable or reusable food packing.

The Lishman Health Foundation This research will gather data about the demographics and health characteristics of patients presenting to Bunbury GPs with unrecognised alcohol and other substance use disorders. The aim is to develop a best practice model for GPs in private practice and community medical centres in managing patients presenting with these disorders. Dr Mathew Coleman, Consultant Psychiatrist, WACHS and Clinical Senior Lecturer Rural Clinical School of WA will conduct the study on behalf of the Lishman Health Foundation.





Investing In Our Youth Inc/South West Regional Youth Driver Educa-

tion (R4DE) This beneficiary will purchase an additional automatic geared vehicle to expand the new Youth Driver Training Program. Approved adult drivers volunteer to mentor disadvantaged young people who have been referred by local care organisations, assisting them to gain the required 50 hours supervised practical driving experience needed to take their Driving

Licence Test (P Plate.)

Projects of the Heart and Soul WA Inc. Purchase of materials to build Bunbury Garden Labyrinth. The Labyrinth will be a paved pathway comprising seven unfolding circles coming to a central point located in Bunburys Queens Gardens. Key contributors are The City of Bunbury, Simcoa, Holcim and Piacentini & Sons. Through the ages and in every culture, labyrinths have been created in natural settings and in places of ceremony, worship and healing to bring the community together. People will be encouraged to move quietly through the labyrinth, to relax, pause & be mindful.



How did you get into being an auctioneer?

I obtained my auctioneers licence in 1994 during my traineeship as a livestock agent and auctioneer. I hold a general auctioneers licence, which allows me to conduct any auction in WA, however I specialise in rural commodities. As a livestock agent I conduct auctions for cattle, sheep, farm plant and machinery and once upon a time pigs.

Why you keep coming back to the event and what drove you to it to begin with?

I was asked to auction the event in 2009 when the committee had another auctioneer unable to attend at the last minute. I was unsure if I could do it as my wife had been admitted to hospital to have our third child. I did end up running the auction and my daughter was born two days later. It is her 10th birthday on the same day as this year's event (I will have come straight from her party on the day).

What has been your favourite item to auction off over the years?

There have been many interesting items over the years such as a week in a French Chatteau and a Surf Life Saving Oar carried by two young shirtless men but the most memorable would be an ACDC guitar signed by Bon Scott.

What are you looking forward to in this years event?

I love the charity nature of the Chef's Long Table Lunch and as much as I'd like to say I really look forward to the auction I'm actually here for the food!

Auctions Terms and Conditions

Terms and Conditions of Fast and Live Auctions

- 1. The highest bidder accepted by the Auctioneer will be the buyer, with the Auctioneer having the right to refuse any bid if it is not in the best interest of the seller.
- 2. A bidder may bid on behalf of another entity. This bidder will take full responsibility for payment of the item if successful.

The Sanctuary

"The Sanctuary" - Auction item L8

The old Bunbury Jetty was held in place with Jarrah Piles, most approx. 18" in diameter (in metric approx. 450mm). the piles were sources from the Pile Road Area, east of Dardanup to the Wellington Mills hence to name. Jarrah was the preferred timber for the piling aspect of a Bridge or Jetty in our part of the world. They would be around 100 years old when they were cut, add about 120 years pending when they were placed; that would make them at least 200 years old. The two verticals on this piece are from original Piles. The horizontal pieces you'll see by the same character holes are from the same piece of timber this section was known as a whaler.

The Whalers however were cut to approx. 12" x 6" (in metric 300 x 150 mm) and were milled generally from trees two to three times older than the Piles. 400 years would not be out of the question for these tim-

bers which includes the life of the Jetty. They were place front and back of the vertical Piles at approx. medium to high tide. Here they endured decades of tidal movements in and out of the water everyday plus the storms.

To be able to rejuvenate this Timber to show some of what's inside and remind us of the role it played in Bunbury's history is a privilege. It is no wonder this timber is so highly regarded. The Bunbury Jetty was also not only a Sanctuary for many fish but as much as a Sanctuary for the people who fished it.
